Subject of possible rule making: Amend 200-100 WAC Self Insurance Transactions as to Local Governments

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 48.62.061 Rule making by state risk manager—Standards

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: Update of the rules is necessary to align with statutory changes, including but not limited to allowing the State Board of Pilotage Commissioners to participate in a local government self-insurance program covering liability risks. Other content changes are needed to align with recent changes to other self-insurance rules addressing purchasing requirements and independent audit requirements.

Identify other federal and state agencies that regulate this subject and the process coordinating the rule with these agencies: The Department of Enterprise Services (DES) will communicate and coordinate with the Office of Insurance Commissioner, which has an interest in the rules governing joint self-insurance programs, as necessary. DES will also communicate with the State Auditor's office, which is currently responsible for financial and accountability audits of local governments.

Other (describe) DES will provide an opportunity for anyone interested to provide input as the rule changes are developed. An opportunity will also be provided for anyone to submit written comments on the proposed rules during the formal public comment period and present oral testimony at a virtual public hearing.
