Governor Inslee's Board and Commissions Staff:

With the unanimous consent with both the House and Senate to reauthorize RCW 39.10 Alternative Public Works Contracting Procedures, I am providing an early notice of my intent to not seek reappointment to the General Contractor representative position.

The opportunity to be a member of an advisory board to recommend to the legislature policies to further enhance the quality, efficiency, and accountability of capital construction projects through the use of traditional and alternative delivery methods in Washington has been a remarkable professional experience. To share a forum of respect and diverse stakeholder engagement with fellow board members has also been personally nourishing through participating in challenging policy debate. The CPARB vetting process is a tribute to the visionaries who developed this forum over 20 years ago.
