The Capital Projects Advisory Review Board (<u>CPARB</u>) is *seeking letters of interest* from individuals knowledgeable in the use of alternative public works contracting procedures <u>to serve three-year terms on its Project Review Committee</u> (*PRC*).

<u>CPARB</u> is a state board created (see <u>RCW 39.10</u>) to provide evaluation of public capital project construction processes including the impact of contracting methods on project outcomes and to advise the legislature on policies related to public works delivery methods.

2 – Specialty/Subcontractor

CPARB's <u>Project Review Committee</u> (PRC) was created to review and approve projects and project teams proposing to use the General Contractor/Construction Manager (GC/CM) and Design Build (DB) contracting methods on projects and project teams, and to certify public bodies for three years to use these procedures without having to submit project applications to the PRC. The PRC is comprised of members from many different public and private entities with wide variety of backgrounds, expertise and experience.

CPARB will review letters of interest during the February 9, 2017 meeting and at subsequent meetings until positions are filled.

Short oral presentations will be presented to the PRC during the public meetings. Committee members will be compensated for reasonable travel expenses.
