(3) The <u>department, with assistance from the capital projects [advisory] review board</u>, shall <u>provide</u> <u>recommendations</u> to the governor, house capital budget committee, and senate ways and means committee, <u>on ways</u> to improve the project delivery methods.

It must include, at a minimum, methods to incorporate more architectural and engineering firms and contractors to be eligible for design build projects, and <u>methods for including high performance criteria with incentives for the</u> <u>architectural and engineering firm and contractor to meet the performance measure in design-bid-build project</u> <u>delivery methods</u>.
