## WA STATE SCHOOL DIRECTORS' ASSOCIATION OLYMPIA HQ OFFICE BUILD. REPLACEMENT DB PROJECT

1. Please address the duration of the RFQ response period and how that will provide for competition.

Applicant response: We believe the four week response period to be adequate for teams to form and provide qualifications-only Statements of Qualification. We will be asking for the Architect and General Contractor team members only. Subcontractors and subconsultants will be selected jointly based on the needs of the project. We are prepared to extend the procurement period if needed based on market response. Our team has already begun to generate interest and contact likely proposers.

2. Is WSSDA a public agency as defined by and subject to RCW 39.10?

Applicant response: Yes. WSSDA is a public agency chartered by the legislature under RCW 28A.345 and subject to public works laws including RCW 39.10.

3. How will price factors required by statute be considered in the qualifications based selection process?

Applicant response: Selection criteria will be as follows:

We are planning to use a cost-reimbursable contract format developed by Perkins Coie and used on similar projects.

4. Tim Garchow is noted as providing 100% of his time during the project. How will he be handling his Executive Director duties during the project?

Applicant response: Tim Garchow's time is listed incorrectly on the application. We anticipate Tim's time to be approximately 50% for DB procurement, 10% design, and 10% construction. Actual time required will vary depending on the stage of the project. Tim is fully committed to the project and will engage the Board of Directors for formal funding and design approvals throughout.

5. Please elaborate what highly specialized construction techniques will be needed for a \$2.6M *(total costs)*, 7,500 sf office facility?

Applicant response: Design-Build is appropriate for this project based on two of the three criteria as listed in the statutes—projects only need to meet one. (The application is not based on the highly specialized criteria.) The criteria being cited for the WSSDA office:

- Greater innovation and efficiency is possible
- Significant time savings can be realized

6. Please clarify your significant time savings realization of four months. The application states the design schedule indicates a 7-month schedule. The construction schedule indicates a 10-month schedule. Are the four months rolled into this stated 17-month schedule or is this a 13-month schedule?

Applicant response: Time savings anticipated are throughout design and construction activities. Design-Build delivery provides multiple opportunities to overlap design, material procurement and construction activities and saving time. The actual design and construction schedule will be negotiated with the successful proposer. Proposers will be asked to explain their overall approach including their proposed schedule in the RFQ process and further clarified during the interview.

7. In either project schedule scenario, please clarify if you have the experience to manage highly specialized construction in a DB role?

Applicant response: Our proposed project manager, Dan Chandler is one of the region's most experienced design-build practitioners. Dan has successfully completed 17 design-build projects since 2004 including the \$2M WSU Visitor Center, the \$1.5M Spring Street Pedestrian Bridge, the \$40M Olympia City Hall and the \$210M King County Children and Family Justice Center. Dan will lead the project from planning and procurement, through design, price negotiations and delivery.

## A summary of OAC's design-build project experience is shown below:

The team's DB management experience (other than Dan Chandler's 10% D / 10% C commitment) appears to be insufficient support to manage a well-executed DB delivery, especially with an accelerated schedule of 13-months. Per your application's Attachment A, other than Dan, the remainder of the team has no DB experience. Please clarify.

Applicant response: The level of commitment listed in the application is approximate and not intended to be a limit in any way. The actual time spent by Dan Chandler and other staff members will be sufficient to execute the project successfully. Other experienced OAC staff members are available on an as needed basis. OAC has a long successful history of training staff members in all project delivery methods and will employ these methods on this project. Dan Chandler and Cynthia Balzarini have been working closely on the project since June building the preliminary schedule and budget, completing a programming exercise, investigating permitting requirement and generating contractor interest.
