ACHIEVING ENERGY EFFICIENCY IN STATE BUILDINGS 2015

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Describe benchmarking, metering, audits, and energy retrofits completed by the agency by 2015 to meet the requirements of EO 12-06:

DVA has completed or was in the process of by 2015:

- Investment Grade Audits of its three major facilities.
- Utilized the ESCO process to make significant upgrades to these facilities utility infrastructure.
- Engaged the WSU Energy Program to provide ongoing Energy Star reporting in conjunction with ESCO monitoring and verification.

Describe benchmarking, metering, audits, and energy retrofits that the agency plans to implement in 2015 to meet the requirements of EO 12-06:

DVA has finalized the input of at least 36 months of data for the four owned facilities (Eastern Washington Cemetery, Spokane Veterans Home, Washington Soldiers Home and Colony and the Washington Veterans Home) and one leased building (Operations Headquarters). This information is current through the 2015 calendar year.

DVA will be looking at received additional information from our utilities to evaluate how the work that has been done in the past is assisting in the reduction of energy consumption.

Since each facility is unique with regard to usage and the location, each facility will be compared to itself overtime to ensure that progress is being met through the agencies commitments to reduce energy consumption.

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DVA has performed the following projects either through an Energy Service Company (ESCO) or through capital projects:

- At the Soldiers Home at Orting:
 - Replacement of an obsolete boiler (installed in 1962) with an up to date unit that has proven out to be more reliable and efficient. Initial estimates of positive cash flow from savings was estimated at \$10K per year out to 2019. We have seen in excess of 40% reduction in our gas costs with this boiler.
 - Removal of 8 buildings from the failing campus steam system and installing a combination of evaporative natural gas heat and/or split system HVAC units. Used a PSE grant to pipe the gas and install meters to these buildings.
 - Replace the existing vacuum condensate return system in 5 buildings and upgrade these buildings with a new controls (DDC or Electronic). Optimal start, economizer, OCC sensors, CO2 sensors. Includes commissioning of all systems.
 - Replace or retrofit water closets, sinks, urinals with new, water saving devices.
 - Lighting Retrofit Where cost effective (<7yr payback), retrofit T-12, magnetic ballast and incandescent fixture with T-8 lamps, electronic ballast and compact fluorescent technology.
 - In our skilled nursing building, repair/replace failed valves, replace steam regulator valves on the hot water system, install eductors on the steam trap lines to alleviate water hammer in the pumped condensate return to the steam plant and clean all Nursing Care main AHU heating hot water coils.
- At the Veterans Home at Retsil:
 - Lighting Retrofit Where cost effective (<7yr payback), retrofit T-12, magnetic ballast and incandescent fixture with T-8 lamps, electronic ballast and compact fluorescent technology.
 - Replace or repair failed fire/smoke dampers & provide access where needed. This restored the air flow necessary to evenly distribute heat to the residents.
- At the Spokane Veterans Home:
 - We have installed a Silk Road Solar Heating Array and System.
 This includes an extensive roof top array of solar heated water panels, piping, storage tanks and a replacement smaller and more efficient domestic water heater in the existing system.

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- We installed Variable Frequency Drives to the Kitchens Mechanical Air Unit's and Exhaust Fan's. All these exhaust fans and air handling units had run at full speed all day. They now operated more appropriately on demand and we now shut them off in between meal periods resulting in a greatly reduced energy cost.
- We performed re-balancing of the building. The changes in the exhaust profiles had left the building under negative pressure. This effort returned the building to slight positive pressure resulting in less energy consumed as well as increasing resident comfort.

Describe how the agency used Energy Star Portfolio Manager benchmarking in lease negotiations for new or renewed leases in 2012:

We have not used the data to negotiate a new or renewal lease up to 2015.

Describe actions that will be taken to save energy through operational changes and continuous monitoring using Portfolio Manager:

No direct operational changes have been seen due to the information added to Portfolio Manager.

The usage of the owned facilities do not fully meet any of the specified building types as they are defined in Portfolio Manager and thus an Energy Star Rating is not currently available for consideration.
