


Fiscal Year 2021 Frequency / Severity


84% of event payouts are less than \$100,000 each and make up 3% of total dollars paid out for indemnities.

76 events resulting in claims paid are greater than \$100,000









Large Payouts Result from a Small Number of Events (Severity = High / Frequency = Low)


