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Describe benchmarking, metering, audits, and energy retrofits completed by the agency in 2014 to meet the requirements of EO 12-06:

The Military Dept. received a grant from the Dept. of Commerce and was awarded \$194,361 in state grant funds from the Energy Efficiency project grant. These funds were used for energy conservation measures (ECMs) for six different facilities with services provided by an ESCO contract with DES that included an IGA per facility. There were 27 electric smart meters installed, 3 electric smart meter pulse transmitters, and 18 gas smart meters installed in 2014.

Describe benchmarking, metering, audits, and energy retrofits that the agency plans to implement in 2015 to meet the requirements of EO 12-06:

The Military Dept. applied for a grant from the Dept. of Commerce for \$400,000 that will allow for energy conservation measures (ECMs) for eight different facilities with services provided by an ESCO contract with DES that will include an IGA per facility. There are three smart meters at JBLM that will be connected to the smart meter network in 2015.
