ACHIEVING ENERGY EFFICIENCY IN STATE BUILDINGS December 2014

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Describe benchmarking, metering, audits, and energy retrofits completed by the agency in 2014 to meet the requirements of EO 12-06:

The agency leases space in two buildings: the Natural Resources Building (NRB) (Olympia) and the Center for Urban Waters (CUW) (Tacoma). The NRB is a state-owned facility and reporting will be completed by Department of Enterprise Systems. The CUW is privately owned and is a LEED Platinum building. We are continually working with the building owner to identify ways to save energy in the building. This is the first time the Puget Sound Partnership is reporting under the Executive Order.

Describe benchmarking, metering, audits, and energy retrofits that the agency plans to implement in 2015 to meet the requirements of EO 12-06:

Since we have not reported in the past and we do not have benchmarks in place, we will work with the building owner to include the CUW building in the EPA Portfolio manager and complete initial benchmarking. We will require key staff take Energy Star On-Line Training Sessions. When negotiating new leases or renewals, we will take energy savings into consideration.
