Service Highlights



We provide workplace solutions that enhance government's ability to fulfill their missions.

- Goods and services contracts | Manage 200 statewide contracts with 1,500+ vendors, resulting in \$1.9B in annual goods and services purchases.
- Construction projects | Manage 800+ design and construction projects worth \$400M+ each year.
- **Statewide facilities** | Care for government facilities totaling 180,000+ square feet and 14 acres in Cowlitz, King, Thurston and Yakima counties.
- **Building leases** | Administers 700+ active leases totaling 9.5M+ square feet with rents totaling \$185M+ each year.



We help government get the best value for mission-support services.

- Surplus | Recycle, reuse and sell materials, keeping 600,000+ pounds of materials out of landfills each year, returning 80% of funds generated to agencies.
- **Fleet** | Manage vehicle purchases, long- and shortterm leases, and repairs and maintenance for a fleet of 5,000+ vehicles.
- **Technology leases** | Help government reduce costs when replacing old equipment like computers, printers and servers.



We support government in meeting their modern workforce needs.

- **Training** | Manage the Washington State Learning Center with a library of 1,200+ online classes.
- EAP | Provide support through the Washington State Employee Assistance Program to promote the health and well-being for 100,000+ public employees.
- **Careers.wa.gov** | Administer the state's online recruiting system, with 1,400+ job postings and 25,800+ online applications received monthly.



We reduce government risk and add value through our stewardship and services.

- **Risk management** | Provide risk management services and process 3,000 legal claims per year.
- Small agency support | Provide human resources, financial, and contracting and procurement services to small agencies.
- **Mail** | Process 4M pieces of incoming, outgoing and campus mail, saving an estimated \$5M in postage per year.
- **Printing** | Print 14M images per month, including sensitive documents and items for governments such as vehicle titles and voter pamphlets.
