CCDAC Member Recruitment – Architect Position

Purpose: Information

The purpose of this agenda item is to brief the Capitol Campus Design Advisory Committee (CCDAC) on the recruitment to fill the vacant CCDAC architect position. Department of Enterprise Services' Deputy Director Bob Covington will present this item.

Background

The CCDAC is established as an advisory group to the State Capitol Committee and the Director of the Department of Enterprise Services. CCDAC reviews programs, planning, design, and landscaping of state capitol facilities and grounds and to make recommendations that will contribute to the attainment of architectural, aesthetic, functional, and environmental excellence in design and maintenance of capital facilities on campus and located in neighboring communities.

CCDAC consists of the two architects, landscape architect and an urban plan who are appointed the Director of Enterprise Services. CCDAC meets at least once every ninety days and at the call of the chair.

DUTIES:

The Capitol Campus Design Advisory Committee (CCDAC) is established as an advisory group to the State Capitol Committee and the Director of the Department of Enterprise Services to review programs, planning, design, and landscaping of state capitol facilities and grounds and to make recommendations that will contribute to the attainment of architectural, aesthetic, functional, and environmental excellence in design and maintenance of capitol facilities on campus and located in neighboring communities.

CCDAC consists of the following persons who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Director of Enterprise Services: two architects, a landscape architect, and an urban planner. The CCDAC also consist of the Secretary of State and two members of the House of Representatives, one from each caucus, and two members of the Senate, one from each caucus.

The CCDAC is required, by statute, to meet at least once every ninety (90) days and at the call of the chair. Meetings typically begin at 10:00am and last for about two to three hours. Some travel to Olympia may be required, however when possible the committee meetings are conducted by teleconference.
