New procurement policies posted on website

The final three policies for sole-source contracts, emergency and direct-buy procurements and purchases have now been posted on the Procurement Reform [website](#).

Beginning the week of Dec. 31, Enterprise Services will post comprehensive answers to many of the questions the department has recently received on the three final policies, and the delegation of authority policy.

Enterprise Services will issue the policy on complaints and protests the week of Dec. 31.

State government spends more than \$1 billion annually to buy a variety of goods and services. The 2011 Legislature passed Procurement Reform legislation that consolidates several purchasing laws under the authority of Enterprise Services. The goal is to make the procurement process more transparent, competitive and efficient. Many of the changes take effect Jan. 1, 2013.
