Temporary wall construction is complete, plastic sheeting is being installed

The construction of temporary walls inside the Natural Resources Building on floors 2 through 6 is complete. The general contractor is now securing plastic sheathing to the side of the wall to prevent dust from entering the building. PBS Engineering & Environmental will determine if air sampling is needed each day at each demolition site.

Wall demolition will begin at 2PM on Aug. 27. PBS will be completing baseline air and surface testing over the next couple of days in the interior of the NRB. Air and surface testing results will take from 24 to 48 hours for results. Results will be placed on the DES website.

Roof repairs and scaffolding installation

Roof replacement and repairs will begin this week. Tenants can expect an increase in construction noise and activity.

The double doors on the east side of the cafeteria and rotunda doors will be blocked for a short time as workers erect scaffolding this week. The doors will not be blocked at the same time.
