Roof repairs continue to produce noise

Westmark Construction, the general contractor on the Natural Resources Building repair [project](#) estimates that the overall job is about 60 percent complete with final completion now expected in December.

Wayne's Roofing of Sumner continues work on the roof over the northeast section of the building, creating some noise for tenants on the fourth floor below. The roofing contractor worked this past Saturday and will work weekends, weather permitting, to meet the project deadline.

Roof repairs are 70 percent complete.

Stephens Enterprises has installed about half of the 100 new window frames that are part of the project. The Fife-based company has also installed 64 pieces of glass in the new frames as of Nov. 13, and expects to complete the window installation by Thanksgiving.

With half of the frames installed, Westmark can begin this week to install sheet rock on interior walls. When the sheet rock work is done, the general contractor will paint interior walls, re-install ceiling tiles and flooring and then remove the temporary containment wall.

Exterior construction

The general contractor continues to install the white foam insulation and finish coat of the multi-layered exterior cladding system. Westmark says it has completed about 60 percent of this work and expects to speed up once more window frames are installed. Enterprise Services has asked the contractor to clean up the small flakes of foam insulation that have spread around the construction site and nearby sidewalks.
