Clean-up work ramps up as project nears completion

Daily clean-up has begun of the white foam beads and other construction debris that have spread beyond the perimeter of the Natural Resources Building construction site.

The beads are a byproduct of sanding foam insulation boards prior to installation. Most of this work is complete. Enterprise Services will not sign off on the project until the clean-up work is finished.

The reinstallation of cubicles on the sixth floor is nearly complete. Cubicles will be reinstalled on the fifth floor Dec. 14-15.

The contractor and Enterprise Services will coordinate with tenants to ensure that work areas are restored to the configuration that existed prior to the start of the project.

Enterprise Services is also working with tenant representatives to finalize the schedule for employees displaced by the project to move back to their original work locations. The tentative schedule calls for moves to take place on the weekends of Jan. 5-6 and Jan. 19-20. Affected employees will receive more details soon.

Most of the construction should be complete by Dec. 21, but scaffolding removal and punch list work will continue for a few more weeks.
