Jan. 6 public hearing set for proposed rules for Managing State Print Operations

Earlier this year, the Department of Enterprise Services proposed rule language for state agencies to use in managing their printing operations. After receiving comments, Enterprise Services determined changes were needed. Revisions to the proposed rules and supporting guidelines were developed in close collaboration with numerous stakeholders, including representatives from the vendor community, state agencies, and the legislative branch.
