



Department of Enterprise Services Rules Receive New Numbers

In 2011, the Washington State Legislature passed a bill to consolidate central service agencies into the Department of Enterprise Services (DES).

The new agency is made up of the Department of General Administration (GA), the State Printer, and parts of the Department of Information Services (DIS), Department of Personnel (DOP) and Office of Financial Management (OFM).

Bringing these agencies together required merging their existing rules as well - into a new **Title 200** of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC). Examples of the rules brought together at DES include former DOP rules dealing with employee training, former OFM rules dealing with risk management, and former GA rules dealing with purchasing and the capitol Campus. The rules were all re-numbered accordingly.

None of the content of the rules changed, with the exception of the public records rules. DES has since adopted new public records rules. Also, the rule numbers for the State Building Code Council did not change.
