The Washington State Auditor's Office, is conducting a performance audit of Washington State school districts' and Educational Service Districts' employee health benefits programs. This audit will determine total cost of current health benefits coverage for K-12 employees and whether costs could be reduced through other coverage models.

The SAO is contracting with this consultant for subject matter expertise in the field of health benefits and actuarial consulting to provide an analysis of opportunities to reduce current costs or contain future costs. The SAO will rely on the consultant's professional judgments and actuarial analysis to support its findings and conclusions. The consultant will provide a written detailed report.

Authority

On March 12th, 2010 the Director of OFM granted the State Auditor's Office herein called "SAO," blanket exception pursuant to Engrossed Substitute House Bill (ESHB) 2921, Section 602, with respect to personal service contracts for performance audits. This is a contract in support of performance audit.

Exception Criteria

The contract is for subject matter expertise in support of a performance audit.

Approval Process

A risk assessment was performed to identify programs of highest risk. An assessment of impact was made. K-12 Health Benefits were determined to be of sufficient risk and impact to warrant performance audit. The Director of Performance Audit Larisa Benson presented the topic to the "Board of Audit" who recommended it to the Executive team. The State Auditor Brian Sonntag approved the performance audit.

Basis for award

The contract is for survey and actuarial work. It is cost prohibitive to maintain staff actuarial services. The SAO will perform the "Performance Audit" however actuarial service subject matter expertise is required to properly conduct the audit. Therefore actuarial services are being contracted.
