I-937 requirements are codified in state law: Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 19.285 and Wash-ington Administrative Code (WAC) 194-37. For qualifying utilities that are not investor-owned utilities or cooperatives, the State Auditor is responsible for auditing compliance with the RCW 19.285 and WAC 194-37rules that apply to those utilities. The attorney general is responsible for enforcing compliance.
