**NOTICE TO CONSULTANTS
REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

SERVICES REQUIRED for Project No. 2016-136; Main Building South Wing Renovation on Spokane Community College Campus; Community Colleges of Spokane; Spokane, Washington.

NOTE: The successful consultant team will NOT be eligible to participate in any Design Build team for this project.

Scope of Work

Provide consulting services required to create a project predesign (e.g., investigation of existing conditions, development of space programming information, development of cost estimate, verification of maximum allowable design and construction cost [MADCC], bridging documents, the Request for Qualifications (RFQ), and Request for Proposals (RFP) for the selection of a Design-Build firm for a renovation and new addition project in Building 1 on the Spokane Community College Campus. The renovation (est. 50,849 SF) is located in the South Wing of Building 1, and the addition of classrooms and offices (est. 6,969 SF) will be located at the west end of the south wing. Services may include, as determined by the State, participation in the Design-Build Team selection process.

Consultants should have a strong knowledge of Washington State Design Build as defined by RCW 39.10 with guarantee for energy, operations, and maintenance performance, and LEED/high performance buildings processes, and experience writing performance standards and specifications.

Selection Criteria

Firms will be selected in a two-phase process: Phase 1 – short listing firms based on submitted information and Phase 2 – oral presentations and interviews of short listed firms.

Firms will be considered for interviews based upon the following criteria, as indicated, for a total of 100 possible points:

Qualifications of Key Personnel including prime subconsultants (30 points)

Project Approach (20 points)

Relevant Experience (40 points)

Geographic Proximity of 50 miles (5 points)

Diverse Business Inclusion Plan (5 points)

Other Information

The Agreements for Consultant services will be the standard Office of Engineering and Architectural Services Agreement and fees will be negotiated when applicable, on a current Architectural/Engineering Fee Schedule for Washington State Public Works Building Projects.

All submitting firms are encouraged to register in Washington's Electronic Business Solution Application (WEBS) at: <https://fortress.wa.gov/ga/webs/>.

Based upon the selected contract delivery system the state reserves the right to continue with the consultant selected or has the option to conduct a new consultant selection process for future services beyond those services advertised above and separate from the Design Build contract services.

Voluntary numerical Diverse Business Inclusion goals have been established for the project as: 12% MBE and 8% WBE, and 5% Washington Small Business and 5% Veterans have been established for this project. Achievement of the goals is encouraged. However, no minimum level of Diverse Business participation shall be required as a condition of A/E selection.

Proposals will not be rejected or considered non-responsive if they do not include diverse Business participation, but plan for Diverse Business Inclusion is required. Next Steps

Following the Phase 1 evaluation of these submittals, the consultant selection board will interview top ranked short-listed firms. The ranking is based on evaluation of submitted information (as well as reference checks, when performed with Phase 1) from firms deemed to be the most highly qualified for the required service.

The Phase 2 interview criteria will be provided to the short-listed firms. The top ranking Phase 2 firms will be selected.

Phase II Interviews will be scheduled for the week of **April 14th** in **Spokane, WA**.

Firms will be notified of the selection results the week of **April 18th**.
