

<p>The Newhouse Building, previously known as the Highways Building, was the fourth building constructed on the capitol campus, and the first reinforced concrete frame building on campus. The State Highway Department was the building's first occupant and resided there until the 1950's. Construction was completed in three months and utilized Federal relief funding and Civil Works Administration labor.</p>
