SERVICES REQUIRED for PROJECT NO. 2016-311; Replace High Voltage Equipment and Generators; Department of Corrections, Washington Corrections Center (WCC); Shelton, WA.

Scope of Work

Provide consulting services for the upgrade of the High Voltage Distribution System infrastructure and emergency generation at WCC. Work to include the replacement of switches, associated panels, oil-filled transformers and switchgear; and replaces 15 stand-alone emergency generators with a new Central Generator Plant. The work will consist of the predesign (only) for phased facility improvements (Phase 1 – Electrical, and Phase 2 – Emergency Generation).

*MACC: \$3.6 million (both Phase 1 & 2)
Design Services: Completed by April 2016*

Selection Criteria

Firms will be considered for interviews based upon the following criteria, as indicated, for a total of 100 possible point:

Qualifications of Key Personnel (25 points);
Previous Performance (20 points)
Relevant Experience (25 points)
Work Plan (20 points)
Diverse Business Inclusion Plan (10 points)

Other Information

The Agreements for Consultant services will be the standard Office of Engineering and Architectural Services Agreement and fees will be negotiated when applicable, on a current Architectural/Engineering Fee Schedule for Washington State Public Works Building Projects.

Consultants should have a strong background in multi-phased State Agency Construction, and work with continually occupied facilities.

The state reserves the right to continue with the consultant selected or has the option to conduct a new consultant selection process for future services beyond those services advertised above.

Voluntary numerical Diverse Business Inclusion goals have been established for the project as: 12% MBE and 8% WBE, and 5% Washington Small Business and 5% Veterans have been established for this project. Achievement of the goals is encouraged. However, no minimum level of Diverse Business participation shall be required as a condition of A/E selection. Proposals will not be rejected or considered non-responsive if they do not include diverse Business participation, but plan for Diverse Business Inclusion is required. Next Steps

Following the Phase 1 evaluation of these submittals, the consultant selection board will interview top ranked short-listed firms. The ranking is based on evaluation of submitted information (as well as reference checks, when performed with Phase 1) from firms deemed to be the most highly qualified for the required service.

The Phase 2 interview criteria will be provided to the short-listed firms. The top ranking Phase 2 firm will be selected.

Phase II Interviews will be scheduled for the week of **October 5, 2015** at **DOC Headquarters**.

Firms will be notified of the selection results the week of October 12, 2015.
