USPS to add an extra day to First-Class mail delivery

First-Class mail will take an extra day for delivery

The United States Postal Service (USPS) announced recently that inbound and outbound First-Class mail will take at least one extra day to be delivered, beginning Jan. 5, 2015. This change to only applies to First-Class mail. Delivery schedules for Priority Mail Express, Priority Mail or package services will not change.

This change in service standards is a continuation of budget adjustments by the USPS as it consolidates and refines its resources.

USPS to maintain product and service prices

There will be no price increases at the USPS in January. The current pricing of postal products and services will remain the same through the holiday season and early part of 2015. Customers will be given advance notice of any future price changes.
