### Self-Insurance Liability Program Actuarial Overview

The outside actuary hired by the Office of Risk Management gave a presentation at the June 25, 2013 Risk Manager's meeting. Mujtaba Datto and John Griffith from AON Risk Consultants presented an overview of the state's outstanding liabilities and projected losses for the 2013-15 biennium. Of significance, the actuarial review indicates downward trends in the State's outstanding liabilities (from \$763 Million in 2010 to \$559 Million in 2013) as well as a reduction in claims filed against the State during the same time frame. Also noteworthy, of all general liability claims paid, 91% cost less than \$50,000 per claim. The remaining 9% account for 96% of the total dollars paid out on claims.
