I am pleased to submit the Department of Financial Institutions (DFI) progress report on Executive Order 12-06 for 2013. We continue to work with our building owner to find and implement energy efficiencies as opportunities allow.

During the 2012 lease renewal, an energy audit was performed by the owners to determine if the building was energy compliant. We were happy to report last year that the building received an 86 rating. This year we have been working with the building owners to recalibrate thermostats throughout the building and to retrofit sensors in the HVAC ductwork. This effort resulted in an additional two points giving the building an Energy Rating of 88.

We will continue to implement energy efficiency measures and look for ways to increase DFI's energy efficiencies to meet the intent of the Executive Order.

Describe benchmarking, metering, audits, and energy retrofits completed by the agency in 2013 to meet the requirements of EO 12-06:

Working with the owners of building, DFI continues to retrofit and make adjustment to meet the EO 12-06 requirements. Specialists were brought in from Sunset Air to recalibrate thermostats throughout the building to assure optimum performance. Lighting fixtures were replaced in the Board Room with energy star rated LED lighting. Current energy compliant rating is at 88, which is up 2 points from last year's rating.

Describe benchmarking, metering, audits, and energy retrofits that the agency plans to implement in 2014 to meet the requirements of EO 12-06:

We will continue to work with the owners of the building researching areas where energy retrofits might save energy. We will also pursue getting certified as an Energy Star building over the next few months.
