## Discussion

The meeting was conducted by the DES Project Manager, Thomas Honles, and no discussion among participants occurred except for what is documented in the Question and Answer period, see below. The RFQ document was read through and was referred to throughout the meeting. Attendance was taken by requesting participants to place their contact information; name, company, and email address, into the "Chat" section of the virtual meeting session.

## **Questions & Answers**

Q: What is the current licensing of the facility? Is it Skilled Nursing Facility or Transitional Housing, what codes are applicable to Building 10 for example with DOH? In becoming transitional residential housing, has the licensure of the facility changed?

A: Answer needs further investigation, will respond with an answer via Addendum.

After Meeting Response from DVA: Building 10 is not a licensed Nursing nor Skilled Nursing Facility as they provide transitional housing and services to homeless veterans. There are no facility license requirements for Building 10. Building 10 did go through the Certificate of Occupancy process through the Fed VA (as they receive a Homeless Providers Grant from the Fed VA-38 CFR 61) and the process also included Kitsap County.

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Q: Who prepared the markups on the A-8 and A-10 schematic included in the RFQ?

A: The WVH DVA project manager prepared the markup, basically to show the areas of work, a high-level illustration, not a detailed design markup.

Q: Please clarify the Life Cycle Cost Analysis and Sustainable Design Experience listed in the SOQ submittal requirements but not listed in the Evaluation scoring?

A: Chris Gizzi responded in the meeting that these requirements do not apply to this project scope and will be deleted from this project via an Addendum.

Q: In the markup of the A-8 and A-10 drawings in the Schematic graphic, what is the usage of the upper left ('northwest') are of the drawing, is it administrative area and thus not marked with bathroom changes?

A: The areas not marked for bathroom changes are believed to be administrative office area only and excluded from the proposed bathroom changes.

#### **Comment from DES**

As of November 1, 2022, the DES requirement that consultants and contractors provide a COVID Vaccination Declaration has been relaxed and has been removed as a requirement. However, the WVH facility has site specific COVID requirements, including on site screening process, which can affect site visits and should be factored into SOQ responses by interested consultants. The COVID requirements are based on Kitsap County health and COVID requirements applicable to healthcare facilities, and there are WVH specific requirements which may affect as well.
