


### Fiscal Year 2022 Frequency / Severity


81% of event payouts are less than \$100,000 each and make up 4% of total dollars paid out for indemnities.

#### 112 events resulting in claims paid are greater than \$100,000




#### Most of the events resulting in claims paid are for less than \$100,000




#### Large Payouts Result from a Small Number of Events (Severity = High / Frequency = Low)


