Since our April 14<sup>th</sup> CPARB meeting, below is a brief synopsis of Chair activities on behalf of the board:

- 1. Administrative improvements with DES:
  - Talia to check on what the Governor's rescinding of the COVID Emergency Proclamation means for our CPARB meetings and an in-person location.
- 2. Subcommittee meeting participation:
  - Business Equity/Diverse Business Inclusion meetings attended meetings in April and May. Reinforced the timeline to achieve completion of the report and communication with legislators by the end of June.
- 3. Meetings outside of CPARB committees:
  - Contacted Governor's office regarding status of the General Contractor appointment.
     Provided feedback regarding the participation of the applicants on the CPARB subcommittees.
