

Training Manager's Notification RE: A New Environmental Procurement Preferences Training

On August 1st, 2020, we are pleased to announce a free 30 minute long training that is required **only** for those procurement professionals who write solicitations. *Most recently, it is the same group who were required to take the WA-State EO 18-03 training within the LMS*.

- **LMS Title:** WA-State Environmental Procurement Preferences.
- ❖ Who: This training is required for all Procurement Professionals as defined by DES C&P.
- ❖ When: Scheduled release on 8/1/2020, and must be completed by 2/1/2021. Must be completed within 6 months of any new employee or employee new to these duties.

We have a ready-made <u>Troubleshooting Tips</u> page that you can hand off to your IT professionals and LMS Admins that will answer all of their technical questions about the training program. It also provides resources for additional questions.

This is how we have been pro-active in eliminating technical issues:

- a) We test each course on the below browsers and make recommendations on which browsers to use or avoid as necessary in the course descriptions on the LMS: Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, Edge, Firefox, and Safari.
- b) We test each course and resources using a screen reader and other accessibility tools.
- c) We test each course in at least 10 different agency locations throughout the state. Currently the agencies, who partnered with us are: DOL, DOR, LNI, DRS, AGR, OFM, DCYF, DOT, WSP, and SAO. If you have questions about this process, please contact <u>Sundae Delgado</u>.
- d) We test each course with at least 20 different users throughout the state.
- e) We test each course on Apple and Android mobile devices.
- f) We provide the results of our tests in the Contract & Procurement Training Guide for IT & LMS Professionals.
