WA State User Guide

These are Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA) contracts for public cloud hosting services. For each contractor, Enterprise Services entered into a single Participating Addendum (PA). However, unlike other WSCA contracts, Enterprise Services also entered into one or more Engagement Addenda (EA) with each contractor. For state agencies, commissions, etc., there is an EA for Category 1 & 2 data and a separate EA (with different terms) for Category 3 & 4 data. Please refer to [Office of the Chief Information Officer Standard 141.10](#) for further information on determining data categories.

These contracts can be used by governmental entities to purchase goods and services directly from the contractors. Purchasers must have entered into a Master Contract Use Agreement with Enterprise Services before use.

Important Notes:

- Be sure to reference the proper Engagement Addendum in your statement of work, purchase order, or other order document you enter into with the contractor.
 - For Unisys, use Engagement Addendum 1 for engagements that include **any** Category 3 or Category 4 data.
 - Use Unisys Engagement Addendum 2 or Esri Engagement Addendum 1 for engagements that include **only** Category 1 and Category 2 data.
- Deliverables that will be owned by purchasers following the engagement need to be **specifically identified** in the statement of work.
- For Unisys Engagement Addendum 1, purchasers must identify in the statement of work any **specific or unique security, audit, or breach notification requirements** for a particular engagement.
- Unisys Engagement Addendum 1 includes certain additional liability and security terms. As a result, certain services' **prices may vary** from those listed in the WSCA master contract.
- Users are individually responsible for addressing data security issues.
