

**ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENTERPRISE SERVICES
Restricted Access for Specified Areas of West Capitol Campus - Updated**

Due to violence associated with non-permitted events occurring on the Capitol Campus in 2020 and 2021, a heightened threat environment identified by Homeland Security National Terrorism Advisory System (NTAS) bulletin in effect January 27 to April 30, 2021, as well as anticipated non-permitted events, the area of the West Capitol Campus described below shall be restricted as follows:

- Vehicular access is limited to authorized vehicles only.
- Public pedestrian access is prohibited between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- Public pedestrian access is authorized between the hours of 5 a.m. and 11 p.m. only.
- Pedestrian access is subject to change and may be restricted to authorized personnel only should security conditions necessitate.

Restrictions described in this order remain in place through 12:01am April 30, 2021.


Restricted Area: West Capitol Campus buildings and grounds in the area south of 12th Avenue, west of Cherry Lane, north of 15th Avenue, and east of Capitol Lake. The restricted area is shown in map below.
