


## ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENTERPRISE SERVICES Restricted Access for Specified Areas of West Capitol Campus - Updated

Due to violence associated with non-permitted events occurring on the Capitol Campus in 2020 and 2021, a heightened threat environment identified by Homeland Security National Terrorism Advisory System (NTAS) bulletin in effect January 27 to April 30, 2021, as well as anticipated non-permitted events, the area of the West Capitol Campus described below shall be restricted as follows:

- Vehicular access is limited to authorized vehicles only.
- Public pedestrian access is prohibited between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- Public pedestrian access is authorized between the hours of 5 a.m. and 11 p.m. only.
- Pedestrian access is subject to change and may be restricted to authorized personnel only should security conditions necessitate.

Restrictions described in this order remain in place through 12:01am April 30, 2021.

Restricted Area: West Capitol Campus buildings and grounds in the area south of 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue, west of Cherry Lane, north of 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and east of Capitol Lake. The restricted area is shown in map below.
