Q: Would you like to see the full consultant team or the architect only?

A: The exact number is not known at this time. (4-7 would be a reasonable expectation.)

Q: Will the selected team be precluded from the main project?

A: No, while this selection is advertised for "Pre-Design", the State and College will still have the option to continue on with the same consulting firm/team, into design and subsequent phases through to construction close-out.

A: No. At this time it is anticipated to have around seven members, including David Head and Jonathan Martin from DES, and Patty McCray-Roberts from TCC. The remaining members have yet to be confirmed.
