Project Overview:

- This is a Growth Project
- Involves Expansion of Existing Mid-century Lynwood Hall
- The current building lacks in required & adequate space and impacts effectiveness of offered programs
- 58,000 SF of expansion of LYN Hall will address these needs
- MACC for Building is \$23.4 Million and Infrastructure is \$1.7 Million

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Project includes:

- Addition of Multi-disciplinary Computing Labs
- Addition of Basic Skills and Informational Learning support area
- Expansion of the Library to provide appropriate study space
- Expansion of LYN Hall by 53,000 GSF & renovation of 5,200 GSF to the north and east of the building
- Review By DAHP on preliminary design is required to determine if any mitigation of adverse impacts is necessary
