The Department of Enterprise Services seeks interested consultants to be named on “On-Call Consultant Rosters” to provide specialized services according to the named disciplines in connection with planned and unplanned Projects implemented during the 2021-23 biennium (or July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023).

Successful consultants on each “On-Call Roster” may be requested to enter upon Project-specific agreements based on the professional services desired. These Project-specific agreements may be executed at any time within the 2021-23 biennium, and will extend through the full duration of each Project unless terminated prior per ARTICLE X Conditions of the Agreement (dated May 16, 2005).

The maximum value of any Project-specific agreement shall not exceed \$200,000, and will be limited to a single Project. Enterprise Services reserves the right to enter any number of agreements within the biennium with any consultant listed. There shall be no guarantee that Enterprise Services will issue an agreement to any consultant listed on an “On-Call Roster.”

The “On-Call Rosters” may be used to provide the desired professional services throughout Washington State, but consultants may be selected based on proximity to a geographical region.

To the greatest extent practicable, Enterprise Services intends to include qualified consultants having the following diverse business interests:

- Small business, microbusiness, mini-business enterprises (MBE) as defined in RCW 39.26.010;
- Minority and Women-owned business enterprises (WBE) as certified under RCW 39.19; and
- Veteran-owned businesses as defined in RCW 43.60A.010.

Scope of Desired Services

A minimum of five (5) consultants will be selected to provide commissioning services for Facilities Professional Service clients. At least two of the selected consultants must have a physical office located in Eastern Washington. Chosen consultants will be expected to assist in development and coordination of the commissioning specifications and participate in the design review process. The systems to be commissioned may include, but are not limited to heating, ventilating and air conditioning (HVAC) equipment,

HVAC controls, ductwork, Electrical, exhaust fans, smoke evacuation system, carbon dioxide detectors, laboratory equipment, plumbing, fire/life safety, security, low voltage, emergency power, domestic hot water and the building envelope.

Consultants must demonstrate competences in meeting LEED compulsory as well as enhanced commissioning services requirements. Consultants may be involved in reviewing the LEED training materials and videotaping the training sessions. The Building Commissioning Guidelines for the State of Washington, (<http://des.wa.gov/sites/default/files/public/documents/Facilities/Energy/Commissioning/WACG2019.pdf>) may be used as a guide for typical equipment to be commissioned in Divisions 15 and 16. Chosen consultants may be required to begin at the early design stages of the Project and stay with the Project through completion. Chosen consultants may also be required to check the systems periodically for one year after completion.

2.0 Selection Criteria

Consultants will be considered for interviews based upon the following criteria, as indicated for a total of 100 possible points:

Qualifications of Key Personnel	25 points
General Project Approach	30 points
Relevant Experience	45 points

(Relevant experience includes all services on various owners' Projects, not just state Projects.)

If selected, all consultants and all sub-consultants are required to report payment detail in the DES Diversity Compliance program B2GNow. B2Gnow is designed to streamline and automate compliance reporting requirements: <https://des.diversitycompliance.com>

3.0 Other Information

Consultants selected have no implied guarantee of a minimum number of Projects or amount of fees to be earned during the 21-23 biennium. While specific Projects have not been identified for these services, you may contact the Project Manager listed for questions about the selection and contracting process.

The Agreements for Consultant services will be the standard Facility Professional Services Agreement and fees will be negotiated when applicable, on a current Architectural/Engineering Fee Schedule for Washington State Public Works Building Projects.

4.0 Submittal requirements

Due to the Governor's "Stay Home, Stay Safe" order, only electronic submittals will be accepted. Electronic submittals must be uploaded as a single PDF file, and shall be received no later than the specified date and time specified above for each discipline.

DES will create an access point for a single point of contact for each consultant submitting. In order to expedite your submittal process, view and complete upload instructions no less than 3 business days prior to the due date listed. Your SOQ does not need to be uploaded at the time access is given.

Each submittal shall include:

- Completed copy of RFQ Attachment 1. Attachment 1 is a separate page which identifies a single point of contact for the purposes of this solicitation and will be the main contact for on-call Projects, lists all consultant's office locations and all Diverse Business certifications (if applicable).
 - Attachment 1 should be situated behind any cover letter you choose to include AND before any table of contents
 - If you have multiple office locations throughout the state, please provide the address of each office

5.0 Next Steps

Following the evaluation of submittals (Phase 1), a consultant selection board will review submittals provided by each consultant for each discipline, and invite the most-qualified consultants to participate in interviews (Phase 2). Interviews will be held through remote access only in order to comply with the Governor's "Stay Home and Stay Healthy" Proclamation.

The Phase 2 interview criteria and total possible points are specific to the services listed for each discipline, and include consultant staff introductions who will actually perform on-call services along with consultant's capabilities and organizational structure for providing the desired services.

Phase 2 Criteria and available point scores include:

Key personnel	20 points
Firm capability	20 points
Workload Management Plan	20 points
Organizational structure	20 points
Other discipline specific criteria	20 points

(will be distributed prior to interview)

The top scoring consultants from Phase 2 will be deemed to be "most highly qualified" to perform the desired services within each discipline, and will be added to the "On-Call Roster" for each discipline. These consultants may be called upon at any time during the biennium to scope and perform the desired services.

Consultants responding to this solicitation will be notified in writing of the selection results on or before May 14, 2021.

Final selections will be based on the merits of the submittal provided and findings of each panel during the remote interview.

The state reserves the right to offer the use of the On-Call Consultants agreements to other public bodies through the duration of the 2021-23 biennium, July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023.

The state of Washington is an affirmative action employer. All information and documentation provided to Enterprise Services shall become the property of the state and may be subject to the WA Public Records Act (RCW 42.56).
