

**SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS
FOR WASHINGTON STATE FACILITIES
CONSTRUCTION**

(Paragraphs keyed to the State's General Conditions)

Remove and replace **Paragraph A.1 of 5.07 SAFETY PRECAUTIONS** in its entirety as follows:

1. Required Site-Specific Safety Plans
 - a. WISHA: Follow Washington Industrial Safety and Health Act (WISHA) regional directives and provide a site-specific safety program that will require an accident prevention and hazard analysis plan for the contractor and each subcontractor on the work site. The Contractor shall submit a site-specific safety plan to the Owner's representative prior to the initial scheduled construction meeting.
 - b. COVID-19 Vaccination Verification Declaration(s) Required:
 1. The Contractor agrees to furnish a signed COVID-19 Vaccination Verification Declaration(s) ("Verification Declaration") on a form provided by the Owner demonstrating compliance by the Contractor and subcontractor at every tier with Governor Proclamation 21-14 *et seq.*
 2. The Verification Declaration(s) shall signed by the Contractor in accordance with instructions provided and shall be free from any qualifying comments or other notations attempting to limit compliance with Proclamation 21-14 *et seq.* in any manner. Substitute declaration form(s) will not be considered.
 3. The Contractor agrees to keep current and submit signed amended Verification Declaration(s) to the Owner throughout the contract period. There shall be no additional compensation or additional time provided for preparing or submitting amended Verification Declaration (s) to the Owner.
 - c. COVID-19 Vaccination Verification Plan(s) Required.
 1. The Contractor agrees to prepare and keep current COVID-19 Vaccination Verification Plan(s) in accordance with all applicable COVID-19 related health and safety laws, ordinances, rules, regulations, orders and guidance issued by the state.

2. Within 24 hours of the Owner's request, the Contractor agrees to provide the COVID-19 Vaccination Verification Plan(s) along with all pertinent COVID-19 safety policies, procedures, practices, and vaccination verification records documenting compliance by the Contractor and any of its subconsultants, subcontractors, or vendors at every tier.

d. Site-Specific COVID-19 Safety Plan Required.

1. As part of the project's Site-Specific safety plan, the Contractor shall prepare and implement a Site-Specific COVID-19 Safety Plan, which meets or exceeds the current protective measures and guidance relative to COVID-19 workplace health and safety as established by the State of Washington's Department of Labor and Industries (see [Coronavirus/COVID-19 Workplace Safety & Health](#)) and any federal, state or local health or safety authority.
2. The Contractor shall keep current and modify its Site-Specific COVID-19 Site Safety Plan to meet worker health and safety guidelines and construction requirements, and as needed, shall update said safety plan to reflect planned work and site conditions throughout the duration of the project.
3. The Contractor shall keep current and modify its Site-Specific COVID-19 Site Safety Plan to include any site-specific protocols according to the Owner's requirements as needed throughout the project's duration, and submit the updated safety plan to reflect planned work, current site conditions, and how the Owner's safety protocols will be met during the project.
4. The Site-Specific COVID 19 Safety Plan must be available at the job site during the prosecution of work associated with any construction activities and made readily available for inspection upon request by state and local authorities.
5. The Contractor shall clearly designate a Site-Specific COVID-19 Supervisor in its Site-Specific COVID-19 Safety Plan. The COVID-19 Supervisor name and contact information shall be visibly posted on site at all times.
6. The Contractor shall be responsible to fully implement all aspects of the Site-Specific COVID-19 Safety Plan, and shall provide regular status updates relative to compliance of the safety plan at each progress meeting.
7. If the Contractor, or any of its subcontractors or vendors at any tier, determines a single task or sequence of steps of a planned construction activity may fail to comply with the Site-Specific COVID-19 Safety Plan or applicable COVID-19 workplace health and safety measures, the

Contractor shall immediately notify the DES Project Manager and A/E. The Contractor, together with its subcontractors, shall perform a Job Safety Analysis and identify the specific tasks or sequence of steps associated with the planned construction activity, potential injuries or hazards, and recommended safe job procedures to comply with the most current COVID-19 health and safety requirements.

8. The Contractor shall incorporate all safe job procedures into the Site Specific COVID-19 Safety Plan, and must identify appropriate personal protective equipment and other protective measures to be used to meet or exceed the most current COVID-19 health and safety requirements and other applicable health or worker safety guidelines or recommendations.
9. The Contractor shall provide a copy of the Job Safety Analysis to DES and the A/E at least 24 hours prior to proceeding with any identified single task or sequence of steps of a planned construction activity.
10. The Contractor, together with its subcontractors at every tier, shall review and comply with safe job procedures outlined in the Job Safety Analysis when performing the identified task or sequence of steps, of a planned construction activity.
